

SITE RULES

- 1. Your rod licence & permit are to be carried at all times.
- 2. Rods allowed:
 - a. $2 \text{ rods} 1^{\text{st}} \text{ April} 31^{\text{st}} \text{ March}$
 - b. 3 rods 1st November 31st March
- 3. No damage to swims or bankside vegetation.
- 4. Carp care kits must be carried at all times.
- 5. Minimum 42" landing nets are required.
- 6. Large unhooking mats/cradles.
- 7. Slings large enough for 40lb+ carp.
- 8. All nets/slings/mats/cradles to be dipped prior to fishing.
- 9. Retention of fish after catching up to 1 hour (this allows for the recovery of the fish and preparation of your camera). No waiting for daylight.
- 10. Ensure the fish is held no higher than 20 inches and that they are held over the mat/cradle.
- 11. No sacking of fish
- 12. No unattended rods. Visits to other swims to socialise is acceptable (no more than 3 swims along). If further the rods must be reeled in.
- 13. Whilst fishing, you can leave the venue for up to 90 minutes so long as your rods are reeled in.
- 14. Minimum 15lb line & no barbless hooks.
- 15. No leadcore.
- 16. Leadless leaders/safe zones are allowed.
- 17. No braid mainlines or leaders (unless on spod & marker rods).
- 18. No nuts (including peanuts/brazil/tiger etc).
- 19. Seeds and pulses must be prepared properly.
- 20. If arriving to the venue when dark, please use your dipped beams and drive slowly and carefully.
- 21. All captures to be photographed both sides, weighed and sent to Jim.
- 22. Do not leave litter in swims, if you find litter prior to your fish, please pick it up and notify a bailiff.
- 23. Bait boats will be allowed from December 1st- March 1st. Maximum of 2 rods when using bait boats.
- 24. No baiting boats into snaps, please use your common sense. Failure to do so may result in loss of ticket.
- 25. If a fish becomes snagged and a boat is needed please contact one of the bailiffs. If they are unavailable, do not go out alone, someone else needs to be present. This is the only time boats are to be used (unless looking around the lakes, so long as no rods are in the water).
- 26. When using a boat life jackets must be worn and you must have your own oars. Boats are not used for baiting up or putting riggs in the water.



- 27. No guests allowed on boats at any time.
- 28. There is a strict zero tolerance for violence/abuse.
- 29. The Bailiffs word is final.
- 30. No guests allowed unless agreed with Jim.
- 31. Once a guest has been agreed with Jim, this is for a maximum of 48 hours, and the member is liable for the guest and must ensure the Site Rules are followed.
- 32. This guest must be let in by the member and the code to the gate cannot be shared.
- 33. Maximum 2 dogs allowed per member.
- 34. Your dogs must be kept on a lead or lanyard.
- 35. If your dog is making excessive noise, you may be asked to leave the venue.
- 36. All dog mess to be picked up, bagged and taken home for disposal. Failure to do so could result in loss of ticket.
- 37. Under no circumstance can fish be transferred between lakes.
- 38. During spawning the fishery may be closed for a month at the owners and bailiff's discretion.
- 39. At least 2 works parties a year to be attended by members.
- 40. You consent that photo's/videos of you/your catch may be used to put on social media & the Amwell Lakes website.
- 41. Amwell Lakes reserve the right to change/amend the rules without prior notice to permit holders as they see fit.
- 42. Amwell Lakes are not liable for any injuries on its grounds.
- 43. If you break any of the rules stated above, Amwell Lakes reserve the right to cancel your membership and ban you from the venue. In the event of this happening, there will be no refund.
- 44. No driving on swims or grass (road & parking only).
- 45. Drop off and pick up fishing equipment once it has been packed away.
- 46. No fishing in the snags keep 2 rod lengths away. Be safe (and think of the safety of the fish).
- 47. All bbqs or fires must be kept in a tin/tray/bbq (not on the floor).
- 48. All boats must be turned on their backs when not in use.
- 49. All members cards must be displayed on the side of your tent.
- 50. No poles are permitted at Amwell Lakes.
- 51. All members must sign in and out when arriving/leaving the lakes. This book is found at the shed (member name/arrival time/leaving time/name of swim).

It is important that you read and understand the above site rules before signing. If there is any rule you do not understand or do not wish to agree to, then please discuss with Amwell Lakes before signing. Only sign if you wish to follow these site rules - failure to follow these rules will result in the immediate loss of your ticket (the rules are the rules, there are no exceptions).
